

DIRECTIONS TO SUSQUEHANNA UNIVERSITY PARKING & FISHER HALL

Susquehanna University is in Selinsgrove PA. For GPS enter 514 University Ave, Selinsgrove, PA to get to the University.

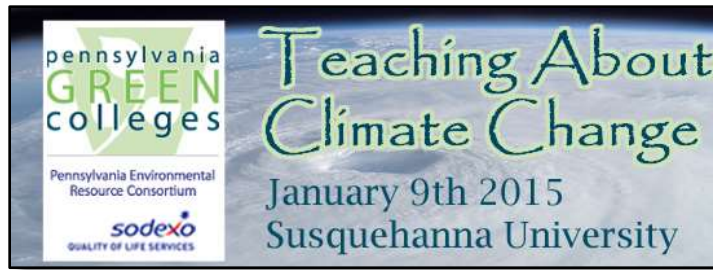
The conference is in **Fisher Hall.** (Highlighted in YELLOW, #63 on the campus map on page 3.) The directions below pick up where Google maps, etc and your GPS leave off... the final steps to finding the parking at the conference site. NOTE: Feel free to park in the spots designated for faculty/staff as the university is not in session on the day of the conference.

From the North...

- When 11&15 merge, you will continue south onto “the strip” (a stretch of highway marked by numerous businesses, gas stations, restaurants, etc.) You will go through 2 lights at the Monroe Marketplace where you’ll see signs for Target, Kohl’s, etc.
- Continue south past the Susquehanna Valley Mall (on your right) and further down, Sheetz convenience store (on your left)
- Go straight through the light where you see Sheetz
- You will cross over a small green bridge, and need to bear immediate Right onto Route 522
- Go straight through the traffic light (see Weis Markets on your right) and continue up the hill
- At the top of the hill, turn Left onto 18th St. where you see Susquehanna Bank on your left (Amato’s restaurant will be on your right; the turn is just before Susquehanna Bank)
- Continue all the way down 18th St.
- When you come to the 4-way stop, go straight and you’ll be on Susquehanna’s campus
- The **Degenstein parking lot** (Blue Highlighting on the campus map) will be down to your left.
- If the parking lot is full, you may go back to the 4-way stop and turn Right. You will pass the New Science Center on your left and then two houses. Turn left into the Admissions Parking lot (Pink Highlighting on the campus map) just after the second house.



From the South...

- When you exit from Rte. 11 for Susquehanna University/Selinsgrove, you will turn Right at the end of the exit ramp
- Continue into town... you will come to a traffic light where Michael's Restaurant is on your right and First National Bank is on your left. TURN LEFT at this light onto Pine St.
- You will come to a stop sign, go straight.
- You'll begin to head uphill and will see campus on your left
- At the next stop sign (4-way stop, intersection w/ 18th St. and campus), turn LEFT into campus
- The Degenstein parking lot (Blue Highlighting on the campus map) will be down to your left.
- If the parking lot is full, you may go back to the 4-way stop and turn Right. You will pass the New Science Center on your left and then two houses. Turn left into the Admissions Parking lot (Pink Highlighting on the campus map) just after the second house.

Walking Directions to Fisher

From Degenstein Lot... (the closer lot)

- Walk down the road w/ the single parking row, between Weber Chapel (bldg. w/ steeple on the roof) and Degenstein Campus Center
- Take the sidewalk at the bend in the road that extends diagonally toward classroom buildings
- When the sidewalk reaches the road in front of the buildings, Fisher is the second building on your left.

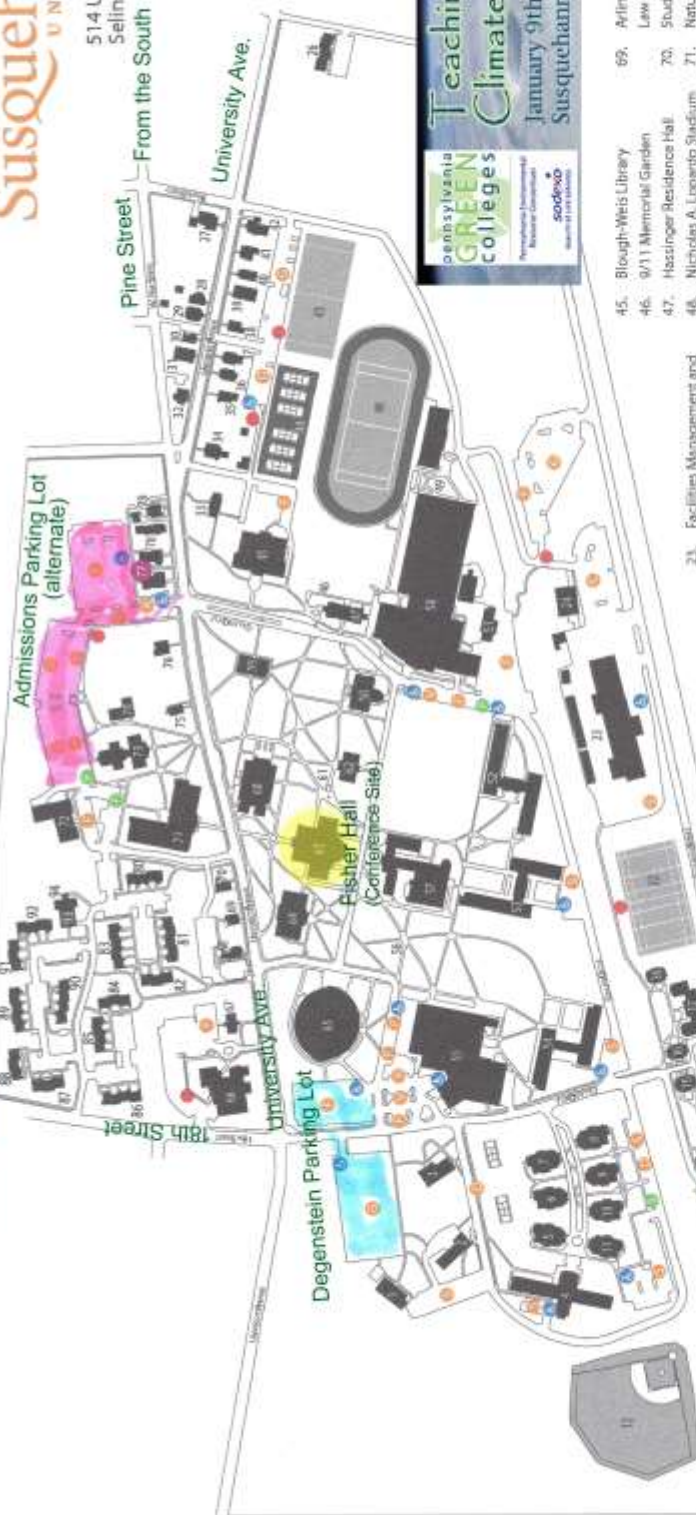
From Admissions Lot (pink highlight) on University Ave...

- Walk up the street until you reach the crosswalk near the Communications house. Cross over University Ave. and continue straight on the path until you reach the road. Turn right and Fisher Hall will be on your right.
