



Call for Nominations Campus Sustainability Champions

PERC Member Schools are invited to nominate Campus Sustainability Champions for recognition at the PERC annual conference, which will take place October 29th on the Penn State campus. PERC's Campus Sustainability Champions are students, faculty, staff and administrators of Pennsylvania colleges and universities who have made important contributions in advancing sustainability on campus, in the community, or in the state. Contributions can be in areas of campus operations, teaching, research, co-curricular programs, campus culture, and community service.

Each PERC Member School may make two nominations, one in each of two categories: (i) student and (ii) non-student. Either nomination can be for an individual or for a group.¹ All nominees selected and submitted by the School's Rep will be recognized as PERC Campus Sustainability Champions and their accomplishments celebrated on the PERC website.

Five of the nominees will be invited to be panelists for the Sustainability Champions session at the annual conference. The purposes of the panel session are to share ideas, recognize successes, and inspire each other.

Nominees will also have the option of presenting a poster at the PERC Annual Conference. (See the Poster Session email for specifics on poster submission.)

Nominations should be made by your school's PERC representative. To find out who is your school's representative, pagreencolleges.org/reps Schools with multiple campuses may submit two nominees per campus through their main campus rep.

Nominations must be received by Friday, October 4, 2013. PERC representatives may make a nomination by sending an email to sustainability@dickinson.edu with the following information:

- Category of the nomination (student or non-student)
- Name of the individual or group nominated, with email address. For a group, please identify one person for correspondence.
- A short paragraph of no more than 200 words describing why the individual or group is deserving of recognition as a PERC Campus Sustainability Champion. A link to a webpage that provides additional information may be included. The paragraphs will be posted on the PERC website, so please write in a style and with language suitable for a general audience.

Nominees are encouraged to attend the PERC annual conference. There is no registration fee for attendees from Member Schools, but there is a nominal fee to cover costs of food and supplies.

¹ Nomination of a group that includes students and non-students should be made in the non-student category, unless the group is led predominantly by students.
